Welcome to the surgery's newsletter. It is now coming up to 6 months that Invicta Health have held the contract for this surgery. Invicta Health is a 'not for profit' Community Interest Company with the aim of supporting Primary Care services within the local community.

During this time, Amy Burt who is the Deputy Practice Manager for the Surgery and supported by Invicta, has stabilised the mix of both salaried and Locum doctors, along with publishing the daily rota. This is so that patients have the choice of continuity in who they see in the Practice.

This rota information has been sent out via SMS to patients and is also on the notice board in the waiting room.

PPG Update:

The Patient Participation Group has been successfully revitalised. Following the publicity at the Flu Clinics we now have 50 patients interested in meeting up face to face every two months to discuss the patient/ practice relationship. We started off by conducting a Patient Survey to get a sense of peoples thoughts about the Practice. In general people were more than happy with their experiences of the Practice. People generally got an appointment for the day they wanted. Sometimes, there was a wait past the appointed time, but the care and time received was viewed as well worth the wait.


